The board of safety, in response to an earlier complaint received by Mr. Fixit, has asked the police accident prevention bureau to investigate the situation and to recommend a remedy.

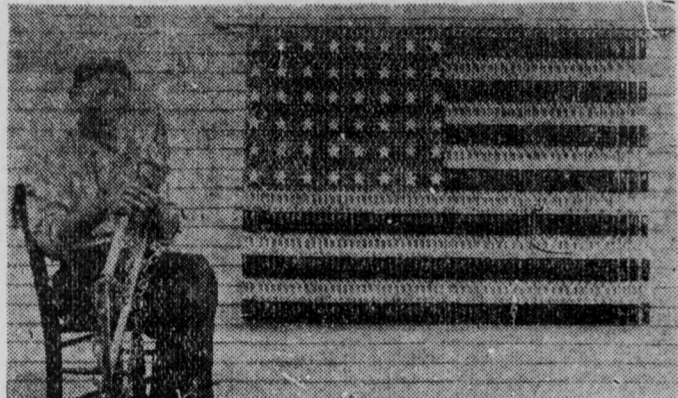
