

# ORSE SHOW AT FORT TO OPEN FRIDAY

Days—No Admission

The first performance of the  
three days' horse show given by  
the officers and enlisted men of Ft.  
Harrison will take place Friday  
afternoon at the military reservation,  
the first event being sched-  
uled to occur at 2 o'clock.

There is no admission charge to  
this season's Army horse show, and  
General Aultman, and the officers  
and enlisted men of the post extend  
a cordial invitation to the citizens  
of Indianapolis and vicinity to be  
their guests on the three afternoons.  
Performances also will be staged  
Saturday and Sunday afternoons,  
concluding with a polo game on the  
last day between the Ft. Harrison  
team and the Rolling Ridge Coun-  
try Club outfit.

Many civilian entries have been  
received for the open events this  
season and some sharp competition  
is looked for in a number of the  
popular events.

The 11th Infantry band will fur-  
nish music on the three afternoons.  
The complete program of events  
for Friday afternoon follows:

Friday, 2 P. M.

Event No. 1—Enlisted men's jumping.  
Prize silver cup. Four bar jumps, 3 1/2

feet high. McClellan or flat saddle may  
be used.  
Event No. 2—Ladies' saddle class  
(open). Prize cup. Conformation, 40  
per cent. Manner of performance, 60  
per cent. To be shown at walk, trot  
and canter.  
Event No. 3—Officers' charger. Prize  
cup. Age minimum, 4 years. Weight  
minimum, 150 pounds. To be shown at  
walk, trot and canter. To be shown at  
the walk, trot and canter, to back and to  
take 3 1/2-foot obstacles. Equipment:  
Officers' saddle strapped. Horses en-  
tered in this class not to be shown in  
hunters' class. Conformation, 40 per  
cent. Performance, 60 per cent.  
Event No. 4—Hunters' class (open).  
Prize cup. Age minimum, 4 years. Cap-  
able of carrying weight up to 200  
pounds, 15.2 or over. To be shown at  
the walk, trot and canter, passage right  
and left, to back, take 3 1/2-foot ob-  
stacles. Horses entered in this class not  
to be entered in the officers' charger  
class. Conformation, 40 per cent. Per-  
formance, 60 per cent.  
Event No. 5—Touch and go jumping  
(open). Prize cup. Jump gradually  
raised, beginning at 3 feet. Horse on  
touching or tipping a bar disqualified.  
Set man to ring wins.  
Event No. 6—Polo ponies (open).  
Prize cup. Age minimum, 4 years. Cap-  
able of carrying weight up to 175 pounds.  
To be shown with mallet under saddle and  
through eight stakes placed ten yards  
apart. Conformation and type, 40 per  
cent. Performance, 60 per cent.  
Event No. 7—Artillery horses in  
hand. Prize cup. Type and conforma-  
tion, 60 per cent. Appearance and con-  
dition, 40 per cent.
