

HIGHER COURTS WILL RESUME WORK MONDAY

Largest Docket on Record
Mostly Liquor Case
Appeals.

Indiana's Supreme and Appellate Courts will resume activities Monday after a recess of over two months confronted with the largest docket ever on record, according to Zack T. Dungan, clerk of the courts.

Two-thirds of the present docket consists of appeals from conviction on liquor law violations.

The convening of the courts Monday will just be the termination of the customary recess held during the middle of every May term, which begins the fourth Monday in May and adjourns the fourth Monday in November, at which time the second term starts and continues until the fourth Monday in the following May.

The docket, which is the largest in the history of the courts, is attributed by Joel Baker, chief deputy, to the great number of criminal appeals now taken to higher court.

"Such appeals have prestige over all others because the majority of times these persons are in jail without bond, and it is the ordinary practice of the court to docket them first," Baker said.


In the list of appeals Marion County leads the State with 164 in both Supreme and Appellate Courts; Delaware is next, with 55; St. Joseph, 25; Vigo, 21, and Clay, 15.

At the end of the May term in November Benjamin M. Willoughby, chief justice in the Supreme Court, will be succeeded by Judge Louis B. Eubank, Indianapolis.

Elections will be held in the Appellate Court at that time to determine the presiding judge.






