

OCTOBER AND TIME FOR MOVING ARRIVE

Records Show Indianapolis Soon Should Be Changing to Warm Quarters for Winter Months.

Phil M. Watson, division commercial manager, of the telephone company, estimates that there will be more than 1,200 moves in Indianapolis during the next thirty days. He says that of the telephones placed in Indianapolis ten years ago, less than 12 per cent remain in their original locations.




