

## STATE SERVICE EXPANDED BY UNITED PRESS

Automatic Printer Installed  
in Indianapolis Times  
Building.

The United Press Association, which supplies The Indianapolis Times with telegraphic news, has expanded its Indiana State service by the installation of an automatic printer news circuit.

The new circuit makes available full leased wire report of the United Press for a number of papers which were formerly served news bulletins by telephone and at the same time links papers in the northern part of the State in closer contact with the Indianapolis bureau.

### News Related

From the central sending printer telegraph machine in the Indianapolis bureau, located in The Times Bldg., the news is relayed over leased wires to the receiving machines in the offices of the client newspapers.

With the same speed and accuracy of telegraph wires manned by operators, the receiving machines automatically copy the news bulletins in such a form that they are immediately ready for use in the composing rooms of the newspapers.

### Instantaneous Transmission

Transmission of the news is practically instantaneous. On an important news break it is only a question of a few seconds until the "flash" is relayed from any point on the United Press leased wire system to the papers receiving service over the new Indiana printer circuit.

In addition to making available a more extensive and speedier service for papers which formerly relied on telephone bulletins at stated periods during the day, the establishment of the automatic printer circuit increases the facilities of the press association for collecting State news.
