

## RESS REFORM FOR OFFICERS OF ARMY URGED

High, Stiff Collars. Have  
Been Choking for Thirty  
Years.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 9.—* For thirty years it has been choking the United States Army. When the old War came along, regular men and new ones too wanted chuck it! But General Pershing, is understood, conferred with Wm. D. Baker, then Secretary of War and nipped in the bud any efforts to get rid of it!

What? That high, stiff collar of the Regular Army uniform. Neat? Smart? Sure. But comfortable? You ought to try wearing in hot weather," says the Army. Now, after thirty years, it appears there is a chance to change to a tall collar on the order of that worn by the British army. Arguments being advanced are that it is easier to find a tailor who can make a good-looking roll collar, the roll collar is more apt to cover necks than is the high collar, and men leaving the service to find someone to buy their uniforms when possible. The army men, however, won't budge with pride and health arguments. The collar may torture, they say, there are no records to show it caused apoplexy.

However, the Air Service now has a tall collar. This has broken the General C. C. Hammond, chief of the militia bureau of the War department, is sending out a questionnaire to see how many officers

will vote for it. The order is expected to be issued soon.

Baker's and Pershing's war-time reason for enforcing the high collar was to save the vast number of uniforms which had been manufactured on that pattern.
