Charles Yoke and Fred Bates Johnson present board members are on the citizens' ticket. Other candidates are Mrs. John W. Moore, Edward Harris and the Rev. C. G. Baker, pastor of the Hawthorne Community House.

NINETY DAYS ON FARM

Judge Gives Sentence After Hearing Testimony on Fight.

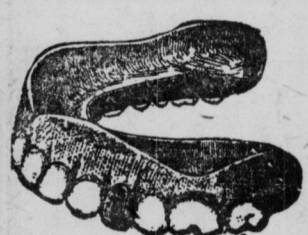

MELLON PLAN IS APPROVED

State Officials Say Proposal Is Good.

Approval of Secretary of the Treasury Andrew Mellon's proposal for the reduction of sur-taxes of large incomes and for an amendment to the Federal Constitution prohibiting issuance of Federal, State, county and municipal tax-exempt securities was expressed today by three State officials who have made a study of taxing matters. According to John A. Car of the public service commission tax-exempt securities in this country

have increased 243 per cent in the last ten years.

"If they were eliminated greater investment in industry would be encouraged," McCardle said.

Charles Kettelborough, head of the Indiana Legislative Reference Bureau, and John J. Brown, chairman of the State tax board, both declared that prohibition of tax-exempt securities would tend to equalize the burden on the taxpayer, and stifle too reckless an expenditure of money for public improvements.
