

BETTER STOCKS INVITED INTO STATE BY LAW

30,000,000 Offered Since
Enactment of New
Securities Control.

The 1925 State securities law has brought twenty-five investment dealers of national reputation into Indiana, who formerly did not operate in the State. Since the 1925 act went into effect, these dealers have registered securities the par value of which exceeds \$30,000,000.

Announcement Made

This was the announcement today of David H. Jennings, state securities administrator. "Under the old law," Jennings said, "it was practically impossible

for the large dealers to qualify an issue in Indiana in time to offer it at the same time in other States. With the steady market or securities, this delay caused the larger dealers to eliminate Indiana from their prospect list.

Citizens Suffered

"As a result, citizens of the State did not get an opportunity to participate in the larger offerings, but occasionally had to invest their money in issue of less strength."

Members of the State securities department believe that, with this large amount of standard securities being offered in Indiana, our investors will be better able to place their surplus money in good securities and will not be forced to accept investments of doubtful character."

BOSTON POST ROAD SITE OF NEW HIGHWAY

Super-Route to Be Finished
for Traffic in Three
Years.

NEW HAVEN, Conn., Nov. 6.—The four-way, fifty-mile "super-highway" being built from New Haven to the New York State line, along the route of the Boston Post Rd., by the State of Connecticut, is the longest paved road of equal width now under construction in the United States.

The highway is being made of con-

crete slab, nine inches thick and thirty-six feet wide in an eighty-foot right of way. It is estimated that the road will require three years to complete and will cost \$4,500,000.

No sooner will this highway be completed than a parallel "express highway" for commuters from New York City will be constructed from the New York State line almost to New Haven. Preliminary surveys for this have already been made and if the commuters continue to flock into Connecticut this "express highway" may be needed before the other is completed. In addition "feeder" lines are being constructed and improved.

The Boston Post Rd., the main artery of automobile traffic to and from all New England is probably one of the busiest highways in the country, taken day and night the year round. In a three day traffic test this summer an average of 12,000 automobiles passed a given

point at Greenwich. The tourist traffic greatly increases the number of cars on this road in the summer but the tremendous growth of shipping by truck causes it to be constantly filled with caravans of great trucks going to and from New York and the various New England cities. Much of this traffic is at night.

LOWER RATES ASKED

The city of Williamsport, Ind., has asked the public service commission to establish a lower schedule of electric rates to consumers. The city operates its own electric plant.

The rates it wishes to put into effect are approximately 2 cents a kilowatt-hour lower than those it now charges.


