

## NORMAL PLANS REUNION NOV. 14

Blue and White Day Will Be Celebrated.

TERRE HAUTE, Ind., Nov. 6.—Preparations are being completed to make the 1923 Blue and White Day at Indiana State Normal, Nov. 14, the homecoming for old grads and former students, the greatest ever. The program will open on Friday, Nov. 13, with the annual girls varsity-alumnae basketball game in the Normal gymnasium, while a big pep session will be held on the campus in the evening.

A color rush and two or three other athletic events between freshmen and sophomores will form the program for Saturday morning. The feature event of the afternoon will be a football game between the Eastern Illinois State Teachers' College and Normal at Memorial Stadium.

In the evening the "N" athletes' banquet will be held. The letter athletes' dance in the Normal gymnasium will close the two days' reunion.
