R. A. Millikan Describes Discovery to Scientists Meeting.

By United Press MADISON, Wis., Nov. 10.—The "Millikan ray" a new cosmic ray with a frequency 1,000 times greater than the ultra-x-ray is in the process of being identified by R. A. Millikan of the California Institute of Technology, he told the National Academy of Sciences here last night.

The new ray, Professor Millikan declared, is the result of atoms changing over to other atoms, having extraordinary absorbing powers and which appear in space from all directions at all times.


