Skull Connects Humans With Ancestors, Belief.

LONDON, Nov. 11.—Because its brain is so small, scientists have reached the conclusion that the Neanderthal, recently found in the Holy Land, is that of a woman. Neanderthal cave girl, the first female missing link in the chain connecting human beings with their animal ancestors.

Discovery of the skull by F. Turville-Petre, British archaeologist and student, in the Neanderthal cave, was hailed as one of the greatest archaeological finds. Its importance is enhanced in that the skull is a female one, and will enable scientists to study the feminine as well as the masculine development of the Neanderthal stage of human evolution.

Sir Arthur Keith, famous scientist, made the announcement of the sex of the former wearer of the skull at a lecture before the Royal Anthropological Institute. Sir Arthur Keith has spent months examining the fragments that make up the skull.
