SCHOOL ON HEATING

Classes to Start at Chamber of Commerce, Tuesday.

Electrical engineers and salesmen from all parts of Indiana will attend the first industrial heating school which opens Tuesday at the Chamber of Commerce. Classes will also be held twice daily on Wednesday and Thursday.

SEVERE BATTLE IS REPORTED

Fight Believed Start of French Syrian Offensive.

LONDON, Nov. 12.—The Damascus correspondent of the Daily Mail cabled today that severe fighting between French forces and guerrillas is reported near Nebk and Hama.

Details are not given, but it is possible this is the start of the new French offensive scheduled for yesterday.

The rainy season has set in, and this will convert Syria during the winter into a sea of mud, which will hamper military operations in Morocco against the Rifians.


