

## HIS FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH IS ALL BUBBLES

Man's Claim to Longevity Is Found to Be Myth.

PARIS, Nov. 13.—Ponce de Leon, with his talk of a Fountain of Youth, returned to France recently in the person of Louis Autram.

Louis told of a mysterious fountain of youth, and interested hundreds of persons beginning to feel the terrors of old age. He himself was 107 years old, and had birth certificates to prove it, but he was full of pep as a 1925 flapper and showed not a single gray hair.

Beauty doctors and youth-preservatives meant nothing to Louis until he finally decided, in the exuberance of his youth, to enroll in the electoral lists and devote a part of his abundant energies to the government of his country.

Then the registration clerk came into the plot. A little cynical, after years of questioning women as to their age, he was astonished when Louis presented a birth certificate dated Jan. 23, 1818, at Cannes. Investigation showed that the real M. Autram had succumbed to old age or diseases some sixty years ago. Louis was taken to the police, where he admitted his fountain was as much a myth as that of the old Ponce de Leon.

CHICAGO, Nov. 13.—One more death was recorded in Chicago's gangland war today when Samuel "Samoots" Amatuna, leader of one of the beer factions, died from bullet wounds received Tuesday night. Amatuna was ambushed by two men, who shot him down in a barber shop.

"Samoots'" death spoiled preparations for his marriage to Rose Pecoraro, his sweetheart for more than a year. They were to have been married in the event that it became certain that "Samoots" would not live, but he sank into unconsciousness suddenly and did not recover. Amatuna, gangland says, died gamely. He never whimpered to police the name of his assassins.

However, the officers testified Jones took his six weeks' old collie pup by the hind legs and struck its head over the arm of a chair. They also alleged he then twisted its head off. Jones denied this. He said he came home from an evangelistic meeting and killed the pup out of mercy.

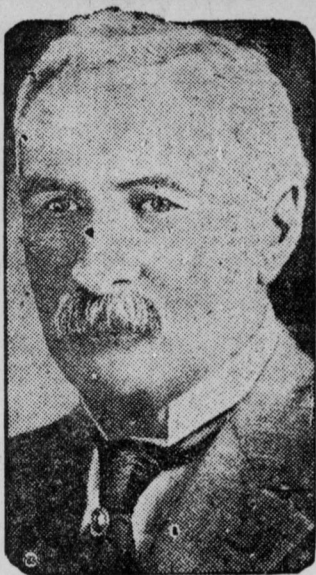
