POST-HOLIDAY MART SHOWS BETTER TONE

Quotations Reflect Unchanged Rediscount Rate in New York.

Average price of twenty industrial stocks was \$100.04 up .86. Average price of twenty rails for Friday was 100.73 up .85.

NEW YORK, Nov. 27.—The post-holiday market displayed a better tone and higher prices, reflecting not alone the unchanged rediscount rate in New York but French political advices that the bloc favoring a capital levy and other drastic measures had apparently been outmaneuvered. The outlook for a new ministry has brightened.

Steel common was ex-dividend and at 129% showed a gain of nearly a point. Cast Iron Pipe was up .5% points at 138 and the motor shares were in urgent demand, with advances of a point or more.

Trading volume was considerably reduced at the end of the first hour. The rails maintained most of their gains, while the industrials gave some ground. The latter development did not occur until Steel common crossed 130 and American Can touched 250, the latter being up 3 points.

Brokerage house opinion was favorable toward the morning's activity. Strength in rails was considered a healthy development. Oils held well at the best levels of the day, reflecting improvement in trade factors.

Sloss Shefford common added two points to its rapid advance on Tuesday and at 126 made a new high for the year.

In the Sugar Market

NEW YORK, Nov. 27.—With purchases in the actual market estimated at well in excess of \$100,000, the sugar market refiners are believed to have placed themselves in a comfortable position for protection against the year's raw supplies. Any shortage will probably be met by the use of stocks remaining—December contracts outstanding. The expected bullish forecast of the Cuban crop is not expected to be a factor in the market.
