



meeting the challenge of life and strikingly negligent of our laws, declared Elwood T. Bailey, San Diego, Cal., banker, at the Y. M. C. A. Big Meeting at English's Theater Sunday afternoon.

"We are the most superficial and indifferent people on earth," Bailey said. "We throw away more money for luxuries than most nations spend for necessities. Last year we juked \$2,000,000,000 worth of automobiles," he asserted.
