

## CONGRESS WILL ACT ON DEBTS

Six Agreements Up for Ratification.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 2.—Agreement with six nations for funding their war debts to the United States over a period of sixty-two years will be submitted to Congress for ratification next week.

With Rumania lined up at the paying teller's window yesterday the work of the debt commission was completed for the year. Eleven out of nineteen countries who borrowed from America have made arrangements to pay.

Congress will be asked to approve the settlements made with Belgium, Czechoslovakia, Latvia, Estonia, Italy and Rumania. Arrangements reached with Hungary, Great Britain, Finland, Lithuania and Poland already have been ratified.

## ACCUSED KILLER HANGS HIMSELF

Tong Warrior, Charged With Slaying, Dies in Cell.

CLEVELAND, Ohio, Dec. 2.—Mark Ham, aged Chinese tong man, today hanged himself in the county jail a few hours before a white man's jury was to say whether he was to die in the electric chair for the murder of Yee Chock in tong hostilities here.

Mark feigned sleep, and with nimble fingers working beneath the covers of his cot fashioned a rope from a blanket as a deputy sheriff sat on watch before his cell. The deputy left his post to make the rounds of the jail. Mark leaped from bed. The end of the blanket rope went around a water pipe, the other end around his neck. Five minutes later when the deputy returned he found Mark Ham's body hanging.

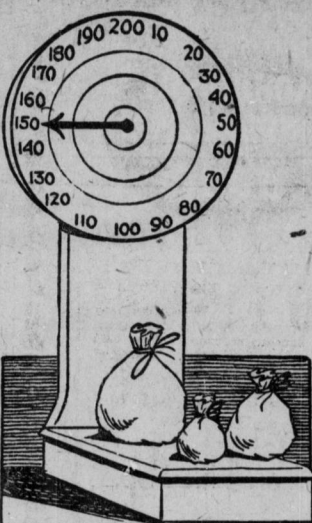
