

MAILING DATES ARE GIVEN FOR FOREIGN LANDS

Packages and Letters for
Christmas Must Be
Sent Early.

If you are desirous of getting your
mail to foreign countries before
Christmas it will be necessary to
have it in the Indianapolis post
office on or before certain dates, it was
announced today by Postmaster
Robert H. Bryson.



BRIAND FACES NEW STRUGGLE

that alterations would mean an over-
throw of the regime when the cham-
ber came to pass on Senate amend-
ments again.

unchanged and left it for the Senate to
consider.
