

MAILING DATES ARE GIVEN FOR FOREIGN LANDS

Packages and Letters for
Christmas Must Be
Sent Early.

If you are desirous of getting your mail to foreign countries before Christmas it will be necessary to have it in the Indianapolis post office on or before certain dates, it was announced today by Postmaster Robert H. Bryson.

A list of places and the dates on which the mail going there should be in the local post office follows:

Dec. 7—Czechoslovakia, Denmark, Ecuador, Egypt, Estonia, Finland, Greece, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, Nicaragua (Caribbean), Norway, Poland, Salvador, Sweden, Turkey.

Dec. 8—Bolivia, Grenada, Guiana (British), Iceland, Newfoundland, Peru, Trinidad.

Dec. 9—Azores Islands, Portugal, Venezuela, Japan.

Dec. 10—Austria, Barbados, Colombia, Costa Rica, Gibraltar, Guadeloupe, Italy, Luxembourg, Martinique, Spain, St. Kitts, Virgin Islands.

Dec. 12—Belgium, England, France, Germany, Guatemala, Hawaii, Honduras, Ireland (Northern), Irish Free State, Netherlands, Nicaragua (Bluefields), Scotland, Switzerland.

Dec. 14—Canal Zone, Jamaica, Panama.

Dec. 15—Dominican Republic, Haiti.

Dec. 17—Bermuda, Porto Rico, Turks Island.

Dec. 18—Canada: Alberta Province, British Columbia.

Dec. 19—Bahamas, Cuba, Canada: Manitoba, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, Prince Edward Island, Saskatchewan.

Dec. 21—Canada: Ontario Province.



BRIAND FACES NEW STRUGGLE

PARIS, Dec. 4.—Premier Aristide Briand faces a struggle with the Senate over the cabinet's new financial proposals which include a six billion franc inflation.

However, he had a preliminary victory with the Senate finance committee following passage of the project in the chamber yesterday when he warned the committee that alterations would mean an overthrow of the regime when the chamber came to pass on Senate amendments again.

After this appeal the finance committee adopted the project virtually unchanged and left it for the Senate to consider.

HOLDS INSURED MAN TOOK LIFE

Coroner Says Auto Accident
Victim Took Poison.

PRINCETON, Ind., Dec. 4.—The death of John Berger, who died suddenly here last week, was due to arsenic poisoning taken with suicidal intent, Coroner Strickland announced today.

Investigation was begun, following Berger's death, which was preceded by an automobile accident. Berger died a short time after his release from a hospital where he told attending physicians he was feeling all right.

Coroner Strickland had Berger's vital organs sent to Indianapolis for chemical analysis, when insurance companies holding policies on Berger for more than \$100,000 refused to pay claims.
