

**FEDERAL COURT
DOCKET MONDAY
WILL BE HEAVY**

Liquor Conspiracy Case
Heads List of Important
Trials Scheduled.

The docket for Federal Court Monday contains more cases than any other docket set for one day in the court for several years.

The trial of thirty-nine defendants in the Jack Daniel Liquor conspiracy case; the trial of Virgil Short, on charges of stealing from interstate shipment at North Judson, Ind.; the Daniel Levy trial, in which Clarence Darrow and Eph Inman, noted criminal lawyers are defense counsel; arguments in the suit of the Eclipse Machine Company, Inc., against the Eclipse Machine Company, 21 N. Alabama St., and the civil case of Florence Robinson, Chicago oil operator, against Clara B. Swain and other Indiana persons for \$500,000 damages, are scheduled for Monday.

Liquor Case in Limelight

The Jack Daniel Liquor conspiracy case holds the limelight. The case centers about the substitution of water for whisky in \$90 barrels in the distillery at St. Louis. Andrew J. Hellmich, internal revenue collector, at St. Louis; Mrs. George Remus, wife of the millionaire bootlegger, and several prominent business men and political figures of Missouri are slated to appear in the case. Remus will be a Government witness.

Short will face charges of selling stock in an alleged fraudulent oil corporation in Gary and Chicago.

Short was arrested with three other men after they are said to have broken into a freight car and stolen articles. The other men are
