An uneducated mountain lad was adopted by farmers. As the boy was shy the wife decided to teach him a few things before sending him to school.


First she taught him the alphabet. When this was memorized, she gave him a book and told him to copy one of the sentences. He painstakingly printed every letter. But this is the result he achieved.
