World's Wonder Line Has Spiral Tunnel.

BUENOS AYRES, Dec. 17.—One of the world's most wonderful railways runs between here and Valparaiso. The line, owing to the fact that the elevation it attains in crossing the Andes, runs for hundreds of miles through a region of eternal snow and is frequently blocked by avalanches. Among its wonders is a spiral tunnel, a natural bridge of rock, and a string of 113 steel bridges linked together by short stretches of solid permanent way.

It was believed that the accumulator was short circuited by the ends of the wires attached to the terminals coming into contact, and that the wires, becoming red hot, set fire to the celluloid container.

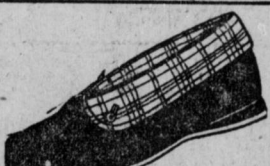
