

## CITY TO KEEP ONE-WAY RULE

Mayor Tells Board It Has Traffic Authority.

Authority to maintain one-way traffic on Meridian St. during rush hours is vested in the board of safety and there is no opportunity for conflict with State laws, Mayor Shank today told the board.

"You stand on your rights and keep the one-way traffic," he advised. "The law says you can regulate traffic on preferential streets."

Shank said a referendum he held indicated 2,400 people favored the system while only 300 opposed it.

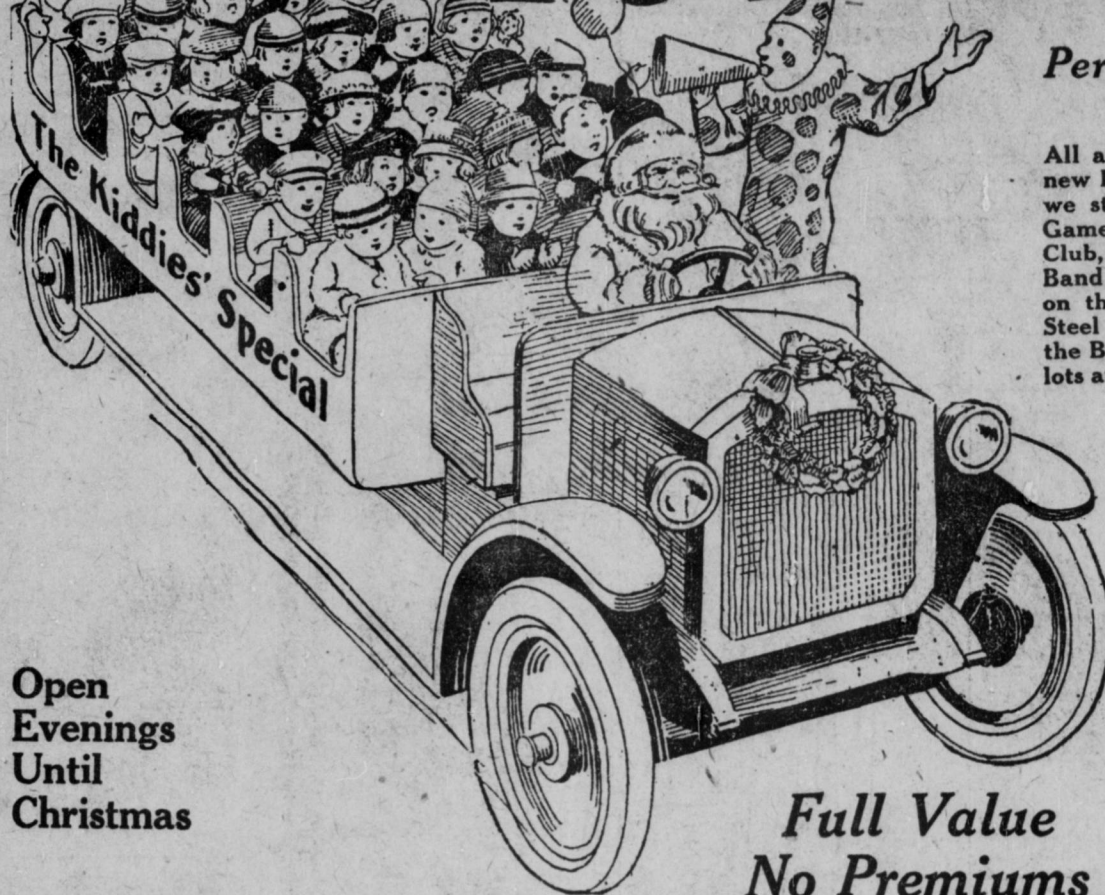

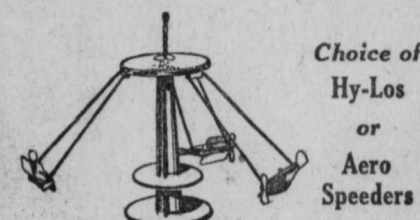
