

AR ON BANDITS WILL BE TOPIC OF BANKERS

Association to Hold
Winter Meeting Here
Jan. 20.

State wide protective organization of Indiana Bankers Association will be one of the chief topics discussed at the mid-winter meeting Jan. 20, at the Claypool.

Protective committeemen and county sheriffs will join in solution of problem of protection against bandits and hold-up men, Miss Forba McDaniel, secretary, said.

Forty-five Indiana counties have completed organizations with armed vigilantes in every banking community. Miss McDaniel said rapid progress had been made since adoption of the plan. Other counties have organizations underway.

Gaylord Morse, State Bank of Chicago, assistant cashier, will speak on County Credit Bureaus and Bank Advertising.

It is likely banker will sponsor legislation creating a Criminal Identification and Investigation Bureau for tracing bank bandits, in the next Legislature.

A. G. Brown, protective chairman, Greencastle, urged monthly rehearsals to keep the organization functioning quickly in an article in the Hoosier Banker. He suggests installation of a secret telephone in vaults to notify officials when attendants are locked inside by bandits. A card with protective officials and their business and private phones will be distributed to every phone exchange in the State.

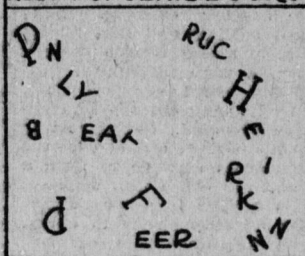

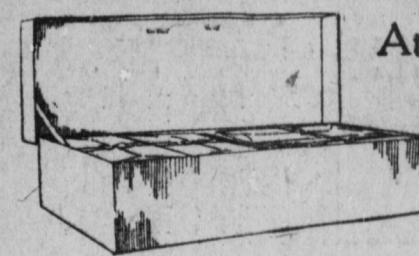
