

SHAFT BEATS MAN TO DEATH

Tragedy In Elevator at
Sharpsville.

SHARPSVILLE, Ind., Jan. 7.—Coroner Sheld today was investigating the death of John S. Drake, 42, killed Wednesday when his clothing caught on an overhead shaft at the Sharpsville elevator.

Drake was beaten to death between the shaft and the heavy oak ceiling. His head was torn off and parts of the body were hurled around the room.

The tragedy was discovered when J. J. Batchelor, owner, went to investigate why the machinery was stopped.

A widow and one daughter survive.
