

BLOCKADES ON INDIANA ROADS ARE PREVENTED

Maintenance Forces Work Day and Night to Keep Highways Open.

Threatened traffic blockades on some State highways caused by recent thaws followed by cold weather, resulting in flood waters and ice jams, were prevented by maintenance forces working day and night to keep these traffic lanes open. It was disclosed today in the State highway commission's traffic bulletin.

Particularly was this true in southern Indiana on State Rd. 1, where patrol and maintenance crews fought the elements for hours to keep traffic moving.

Ice and drift jammed against a temporary bridge at Marshfield, blocking the stream channel and causing a difference of about three feet in the water level between the upstream and downstream sides of the structure. Water also backed over the road. It was necessary to use more than 100 pounds of dynamite to clear the stream of ice and debris, and then break up and remove the sheet of ice off the road surface.

Surface conditions along roads entering Indianapolis are set forth in the bulletin as follows:

1. (New Albany, Indianapolis, South Bend, Michigan line)—Detour just north of Peru account of dredge ditch. Detour from two miles north of Edinburg to Franklin account paving.

2. (Richmond, Indianapolis, Terre Haute)—Temporary bridge at six miles west of Richmond.

3. (Madison, Greensburg, Indianapolis, Lafayette, Oxford)—Detour at two miles north of Lebanon to Thornton Rd. thence north through Thornton to Rd. 6. Short detour two and one-half miles north west of Thornton.

4. (Vincennes, Spencer, Indianapolis)—Drive carefully all approaches to temporary bridge two miles north of Gosport.

5. (English, Paoli, Bedford, Bloomington, Martinsville, Indianapolis)—Closed from five miles south of Indianapolis for constructing overhead railroad bridge. Detour is out S. Meridian St. and Third St. Rd. 6. Fenced between Martinsville and Bloomington use Rds. 12 and 23. Use old bridge and old road account of bridge and road construction two miles south of Bedford. At Paoli take

a county road to Grantsburg via Marengo and English. Avoid south of Grantsburg account construction and no detour roads.

6. (Indianapolis, Anderson, Muncie)—Detour around bridge construction at Indianapolis. Use old Rd. 11 at junction of 11 and 37 from two and one-half miles south of Pendleton to where old Rd. 11 intersects new State road. Use bridge at north edge of Yorktown.

7. (Indianapolis, Nashville, Brookville, Ohio line)—Detour around at bridge construction three miles south of Cedar Grove.
