

PACIFIC COAST CITIES FACING RULE BY WOMEN

Seattle and Tacoma Go to Primary With Feminine Candidates in Race.

SEATTLE, Wash., Feb. 23.—Seattle is facing the oddest political situation of its history.

The voters will nominate two candidates for mayor at the primary election today. It is generally conceded that Mrs. Bertha Landes, present member of the city council and wife of Dean Henry Landes of the University of Washington will be one of the two chosen.

Mrs. Landes made a vigorous campaign for the office and at the same time an equally vigorous campaign to abolish the office of mayor in behalf of the city manager plan of government.

Mrs. Landes gained prominence two years ago while acting mayor of Seattle during the absence of Mayor Edwin J. Brown, who was in New York attending the Democratic national convention.

Declaring the city to be vice-ridden and charging that the police are merely winking at conditions, she ousted the police chief, named an inspector as chief, fired the latter when he refused to carry out her orders for a clean-up, and then called in a captain from the precinct who had been banished by the administration. Mayor Brown quit the national convention and returned home to discharge the new police chief and reinstate the old one. Mayor Brown is one of four men who oppose Mrs. Landes.

THREE WOMEN IN RACE

Wife of Street Car Conductor Seeks Mayorship.

TACOMA, Wash., Feb. 23.—Three women are seeking office in the city primary election today.

Anna J. Meyer, wife of a street car conductor, with the title of "Reverend," from a national spiritualistic organization, and with business activities including proprietorship of several dance halls and a real estate broker's office, is the most colorful of the mayoralty candidates.

The contest lies between the incumbent, Mayor A. V. Pawcett, 70-year-old Civil War veteran; V. Roy Harrison, for seven years city councilman, and M. G. Tennant, prominent steel manufacturer.

The Y. M. C. A. membership drive which closed Monday night, brought 1,129 new members, 329 more than the goal set.

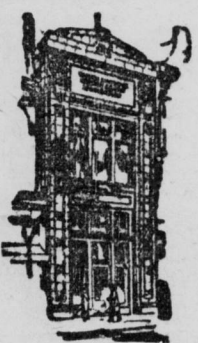
Lester C. Nagley won the Ford automobile offered by Fred Barrett of the Continental Finance Company to the person getting the most new members.

GENERAL SAYS AIRSHIPS HAVE BEEN PROVIDED

Takes Mitchell to Task in Talk Before Military Order.

Colonel Mitchell as onetime head of the air service put into practice many of the things he now berates, Maj. Gen. Robert L. Howze, head of the court-martial that tried Mitchell, told members of the Military Order of Foreign Wars at the Indianapolis Athletic Club Monday night.

"Mitchell is a reformer, and, like most reformers, must resort to exaggeration," General Howze declared in denying charges of inefficiency and failure to provide planes.

MOTORIST SAVES COUPLE

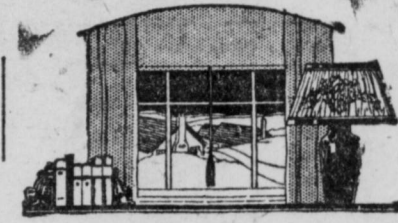

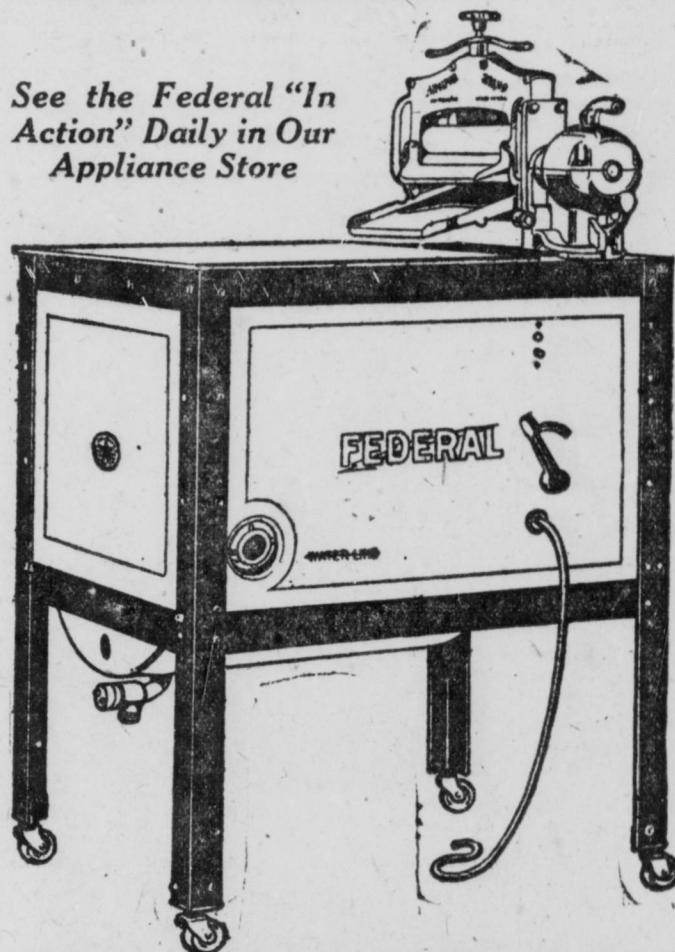
