With the exception of a slight scar on the forehead, Clary shows no physical effect from the alleged blow with an iron pipe.

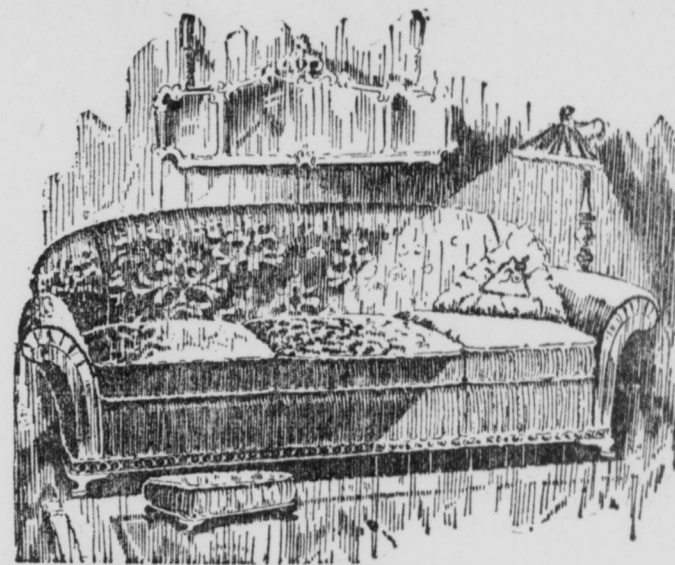
# PLANK ROAD RULINGS

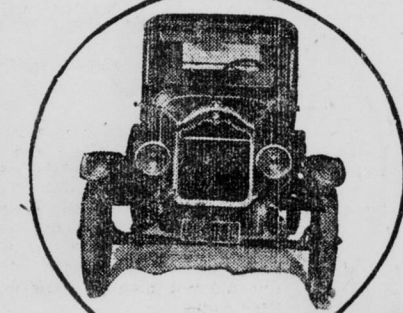

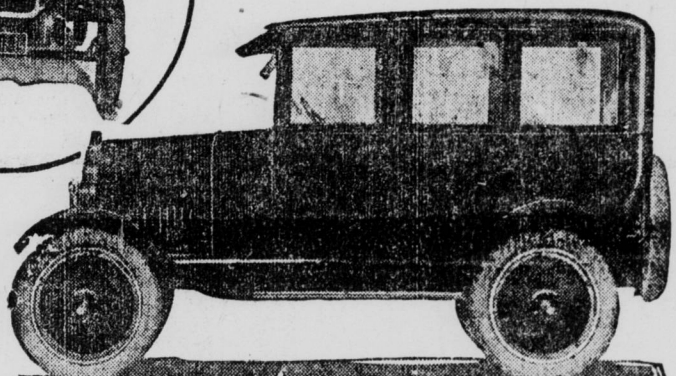
