

STATE HIGHWAY BREAKS BEING REPAIRED NOW

More Numerous Than in Years Past, but Only for Short Distances.

While breaks in stone and gravel State roads have been more numerous this winter than in years past, they are only for short distances and are responding rapidly to maintenance work. A. H. Hinkle, maintenance superintendent, declared in the State highway commission's traffic bulletin today.

Hinkle explained that conditions are due to extreme thaws coming with heavy rains, and to the uncertain climate. No more serious breaks are anticipated.

The bulletin pointed out that traffic started using the new bridge on Road 37 south of Huntsville, April 1, thus removing the detour over old Road 11 through Pendleton. Traffic is asked to drive carefully over the new bridge fills. The last bridge on this route between Indianapolis and Anderson, situated at Ingalls, will be opened to traffic about April 10.

Surface conditions on highways radiating from Indianapolis were set forth in the bulletin as follows:

Rd. 1 (New Albany, Indianapolis, South Bend, Michigan line)—Detour just north of Perry account of bridge dip. Detour from two miles north of Edinburg to Franklin account of paving. Old road at Versailles will serve all traffic, but is subject to inundation by high water.

Rd. 3 (Richmond, Indianapolis, Terra Haute)—Temporary bridge at six miles west of Richmond.

Rd. 5 (Madison, Greensburg, Indianapolis, Lafayette, Oxford)—Detour marked at two miles north of Lebanon. Short detour two and one-half miles northwest of Thornton. Through traffic from Indianapolis to Lafayette advised to use 44 and 45 from Lebanon to Lafayette. Rough and soft on one-half mile north of Versailles.

Rd. 12 (Vincennes, Spencer, Indianapolis)—Drive carefully at approaches to temporary bridge two miles north of Gosport. Heavy traffic restricted at some places between Gosport and Martinsville.

Rd. 22 (Ellettsville, Indianapolis)—Approaches to new bridge between Martinsville and Bloomington. Road closed between Martinsville and Ellettsville. Road closed between Martinsville and Ellettsville. Road closed between Martinsville and Ellettsville.

Rd. 29 (Indianapolis, Rushville, Brookville, Ohio line)—Run-around at bridge construction three miles south of Cedar Grove. Heavy traffic prohibited.

Avoid south of Greensburg account construction and no good detour road.

Rd. 31 (Monticello, Rockville, Danville, Indianapolis)—Detour at four miles east of Bainbridge account bridge construction. Bridge run-around in same vicinity to go in force April 5.

Rd. 32 (Indianapolis, Anderson, Muncie)—Detour around bridge construction at Ingalls removed about April 10.

Rd. 39 (Indianapolis, Rushville, Brookville, Ohio line)—Run-around at bridge construction three miles south of Cedar Grove. Heavy traffic prohibited.

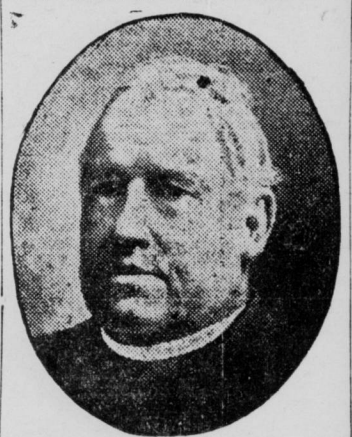
LAKELAND, Fla., April 2.—Sally Pittman, a Civil War slave, is dead here at the age of 103. She was born in Augusta, Ga.
