

HEAVY RAINS ARE HELP TO STATE ROADS

Flushed Off Surfaces, Bulletin States—Some Not in Good Condition.

Heavy rains this week were a benefit rather than a detriment to many gravel and stone surfaced highways, because they flushed off the surfaces, it was pointed out in the State highway commission's weekly traffic bulletin today. The exception is short breaks in surfaces where rains will leave sloppy for a day or so until they respond to maintenance.

Reports show that northern Indiana, particularly in the Valparaiso and Chicago districts, is experiencing much difficulty fighting elements. Early this week the district was swept by snowstorms, and huge drifts four and five feet deep had to be cleared. Usually there was some thaw in the day, but by night surfaces were frozen. As a result of this rapid weather change, nine roads in the Valparaiso locality will not be in condition to serve other

than light traffic for the next six or ten days. These roads are:

Rd. 12 (Vincennes, Spencer, Indianapolis)—Drive carefully at approaches to temporary bridge two miles north of Greensburg.

Rd. 22 (English, Paoli, Bedford, Bloomington, Indianapolis)—Approaches to new R. B. overpass bridge six miles south of Indianapolis are soft. Closed between Martinsville and Bloomington and English and Paoli for paving. Through traffic between Martinsville and Bloomington use Rds. 12 and 22. Use out bridge and old road account of bridge and road construction at two miles south of Bedford. At Paoli take a county road to Grantsburg via Marengo and English. Avoid south of Grantsburg account construction and no good detour road.

Rd. 21 (Monticello, Rockville, Danville, Indianapolis)—Detour at four miles east of Indianapolis account bridge construction. Bridge overpass in same vicinity in force April 5.

Rd. 37 (Indianapolis, Anderson, Muncie)—Pavement from Indianapolis to Muncie. Detour around bridge construction at Ingalls removed about April 10.

Rd. 39 (Indianapolis, Knoxville, Brook-

ville, Ohio line)—Run-around at bridge construction three miles south of Cedar Grove. Heavy traffic prohibited. Watch for police detour three miles from Indianapolis to start about April 12.
