

PROTEST BASE REMOVAL

PETITION INVESTIGATED

Kokomo Leaders Consider Remonstrating Air Squadron Change.

KOKOMO, Ind., April 16.—Vigorously protesting against removal of the 113th observation squadron of the Indiana National Guard to Indianapolis, local civic leaders today were considering carrying a remonstrance to Governor Jackson. Chamber of Commerce officials expressed surprise at the move, in view of recent announcement that the rental on Fagley Field, where the unit is stationed, will be paid in advance.

"Kokomo has been treated rather shabbily," declared Chamber President W. J. Gollighan. Recent conferences with Adjutant General William H. Kershner, which he denied had been held, let to action by the chamber pledging funds to retain the squadron.


