Seven Colleges in Indiana
Give Instruction.

Seven Indiana colleges offer courses in maternity and infancy, according to Dr. Ada E. Schweitzer, director of State board of health's division of infant and child hygiene.

So many requests were received for attendance of high school girls in mothers' class demonstrations it seemed wise to present the lessons to college women, Dr. Schweitzer said. Colleges accepting the work are Danville Normal, Muncie Normal, Indiana University, Butler College, Valparaiso University, Marion Normal and Terre Haute Normal.

The combined enrollment was 1,488. Nearly 600 women attended the lectures at Indiana University, it was said.



PUBLIC STREAMS 'SEWAGE SICK'

Lieber Condemns Pollution in Speech.

TERRE HAUTE, Ind., April 23.—Many of Indiana's public streams are "sewage sick" because the public is neglectful and not sufficiently interested to prevent their pollution by wastes from factories, sewers and streams from cities streets. Conservation Director Richard Lieber told the Terre Haute Chapter of the Izaak Walton League Thursday night.

Stream pollution is the most glaring offense committed against our Indiana waters, but it is not the only one, Lieber declared. Another crime is the deforestation of the State and the ruthless, senseless and unscientific change of many watercourses, he said.

"We have offended against nature and now we have to take the consequences.
