

'STEPHENSONISM' FLAYED BY RYAN

Says G. O. P. Must Smash Political Clique.

LOGANSPOUT, April 28.—Oswald Ryan, candidate for the short term Republican senatorial nomination, renewed his attack on "Stephensonism" in Indiana, here Tuesday night.

"Striving with one hand to force the nomination of its candidates for United States Senator," said Ryan, "while with the other hand it struggles for the possession of the Indiana highway commission, the D. C. Stephenson machine appears to have lost none of its vigor by reason of the enforced absence of its leader."

If we do not bravely meet this issue now, we shall be compelled to deal with it when Evans Woolen, the unopposed Democratic candidate for Senator throws down the challenge to Indiana Republicanism in the fall."
