## BAPTIST TO DEDICATE NEW CHURCH SUNDAY

First unit of the new \$30,000 Beech Grove Baptist Church will be dedicated Sunday with all-day services. The unit to be opened is a sixty by eighty-foot basement. When completed, the church will seat 500.
