

## INJUNCTION IS DENIED MINERS

Judge Also Attacks Jacksonville Agreement.

MORGANTOWN, W. Va., June 10.—The first attempt by the United Mine Workers to use the injunction in an industrial dispute has failed. At the same time, the court which refused to grant the injunction, held that the Jacksonville wage scale regulating union wages in the soft coal fields was signed by persons who did not represent the entire body of the United Mine Workers or the bituminous operator. In circuit court late Wednesday Judge I. Grant Lazelle dismissed the petition for an injunction seeking to compel four large companies of the Purselove and Pasley interests at Cleveland to operate under union agreement. These mines were opened on the nonunion basis this spring after having been operated under the union scale. The court held that the time has not yet arrived in America when a few men can make a contract whereby they can guarantee the services of thousands of men to any company or industry.

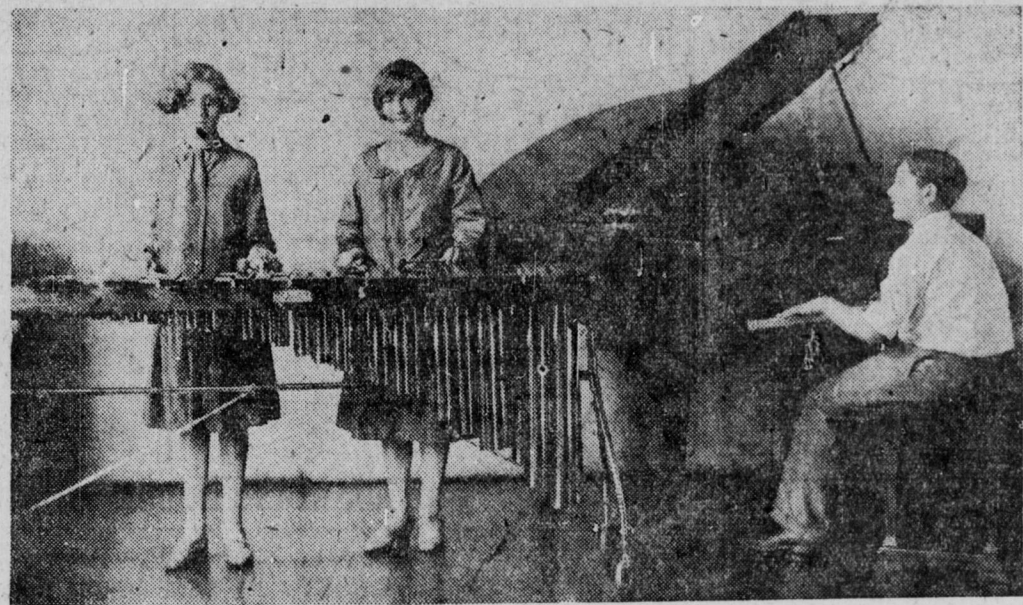
