DURKIN PLANS APPEAL

Slayer Denied New Trial by Chicago
Judge.

CHICAGO, July 28.—Attorneys today were preparing to file an appeal to the Illinois Supreme Court following the sentencing of Martin Durkin yesterday to thirty-five years in the penitentiary for the murder of Federal Agent Edwin Shanahan. Before sentencing Durkin, Judge Harry S. Miller refused him a new trial. Durkin was granted a thirty-day stay of mittimus, however, for time to file an appeal to the higher court.

Durkin's blackened eyes and bruised cheeks, evidence of an attack upon him by fellow prisoners in the Cook County jail after he was said to have made insulting remarks about their women friends, brought many curious spectators to the court room.

MAKING INCREASE IN INSTALLATION OF OIL BURNERS

French-Imes Sales Com-
pany Reports Big Sales
This Month.

July business has shown a decided
increase over June in spite of the

At End of Month
A pedastaled entrance is built at
the east end of the covered porch,

neutral tone. Built-in compartments
on the south and west walls add con-
venience.

to the north from the kitchen.
