

NATIVE INSECTS IN FAIR DISPLAY

Conservation Heads Plan Extensive Exhibit.

Many specimens of insect life and scale pests native to Indiana will be on display in a huge exhibit now being prepared for the State fair by the Indiana conservation department.

Exhibit will be in the left wing of the horticultural bldg. and will occupy a frontage of 200 feet.

Frank N. Wallage, State entomologist, and his assistants will show various forms of insect life that do the most damage to Hoosier crops and fruits.

In the apiculture inspection division there will be a complete exhibit of modern equipment essential to maximum honey production. Modern hives and yard equipment will be shown, together with obsolete type hives, such as nail kegs and hollow logs formerly used. Stress will be laid on marketing conditions and the exhibit will include samples of honey as prepared for the consumer.

C. O. Yost, State apiculture inspector, points out that about 21,000 people of Indiana own bees and are producing better than seven million pounds of honey annually. About the same number of persons kept bees ten years ago, but produced only a million and a half pounds annually.

Yost called attention today to two forthcoming beekeepers' meetings. On Aug. 23-24 a meeting will be held at Goshen. On Sunday, Aug. 29, beekeepers of counties of Allen, Noble, Steuben, De Kalb and LaGrange will hold an all-day picnic at Circle Park, Hamilton Lake, in Steuben County.

DAUGHTER-SLAYER IS GIVEN DEATH

Two Women on Jury Which Convicts Gaines.

SEATTLE, Wash., Aug. 20.—Facing a death sentence for the murder of his daughter, Wallace C. Gaines restlessly paced his cell today, his nerves broken, while attorneys prepared an appeal to delay sentence.

Gaines began to give way under the strain of the trial during the State's argument, when Prosecutor E. D. Colvin charged that "A strange and unnatural relation" existed between father and daughter.

He rose from his seat, glaring at

the prosecutor, and started to mutter oaths. He was restrained by his wife, Elizabeth, who has insisted on his innocence and remained by him at all court sessions. She persuaded him to resume his seat, where he fidgeted and kept his smoldering gaze on the prosecution lawyers.


