

SHORTRIDGE TO MAKE MEMORIAL CITY PROJECT

Alumni Decides to Request Aid of School Board in New Plan.

City officials will cooperate with Shortridge High School Alumni Association and may aid in erecting an Indianapolis teachers' memorial at the new school, it was announced today.

Board members are interested in the association's suggestion that the movement for a \$25,000 memorial to five veteran teachers be halted and a new project started.

Will Ask Committee

The association will ask the board to select a memorial committee to represent every phase of school instruction in Indianapolis. At a meeting of alumni at Caleb Mills hall Thursday night, it was said, "the memorial, as planned, is not right."

It was contended that the memorial would not harmonize with the school structure and not properly represent teaching in Indianapolis.

It was requested that the school board sponsor the move to make it more comprehensive.

Mrs. Lillian Sedwick, school commissioner, heartily approved the project and was positive the board will consider it. She said the memorial should include two teachers now in the school, Amelia Platter and Angeline Carey.

Principal Has Projects

Association plans call for a memorial to Nebraska Cropsey, Laura Donnan, Charity Dye, Mary Nicholson and Rhoda E. Shelleck.

Principal George Buck said he hoped alumni would support three other proposals: An athletic field, scholarship fund, for Shortridge graduates, and a pipe organ for the auditorium.

LABOR INQUIRY STOPS

Federation Does Not Get Report on Senate Candidates.

VINCENNES, Ind., Aug. 27.—The proposed investigation by the State Federation of Labor of the fitness of candidates of both political parties for the United States Senate was sidetracked today after a heated tilt on the federation convention floor.

A committee reported late Thursday that it had not had sufficient time to make a complete investigation and that it would refer the matter to the executive board.

T. N. Taylor of Terre Haute, federation president, charged the committee was "trying to pass the buck." The resolution of the committee for investigation of the candidates by the executive board was tabled.
