

FEDERAL CONTROL OF RADIO TO END CHAOS OF PRESENT

Regulation Bill Expected to Be Passed in December.

Times Washington Bureau, 1522 New York Avenue. WASHINGTON, Sept. 17.—Federal control of radio broadcasting will be resumed by New Year's, in the opinion of Senator C. C. Dill of Washington, author of the radio regulation bill which passed the Senate.

Senator Dill believes that differences between the House and Senate over what form of control shall be provided will be settled speedily after Congress reconvenes in December and that the present chaotic situation will be terminated.

The two bills are still in "conference" between the House and Senate. Both measures provide commissions for the regulation of broadcasting, although the Senate bill eliminates authority entirely from Secretary of Commerce Hoover. The House bill retains Hoover's control, but gives the last word to a commission to whom appeals may be taken from Hoover decisions.

"Just what sort of compromise will finally be recommended to Congress is too early to forecast," Dill said. Dill, Senators Watson of Indiana and Gooding of Idaho, and Representatives White of Maine, Scott of Michigan, Lehbach of New Jersey, Davis of Tennessee, and Lazaro of Louisiana, will represent the two houses at the conference.

"The anticipated chaos from the attorney general's opinion that Hoover is without authority under existing law, to regulate radio has not resulted," Senator Dill observed. "There has been some piracy of wave lengths, of course, but nothing like what it was believed there might be. Hoover has only himself to blame for inviting an opinion which he was without authority."

"Hoover literally invited broadcasters to do their worst—and they refused to do it. Those making broadcasting a business are anxious for proper government control and supervision and my information is they plan to stand by, as is, until Congress enacts a control law."

The forthcoming radio legislation will provide for control of telephones and telegraph also.

PRINCE OF WALES WEARS PINK SHIRT

LONDON, Sept. 17.—Pink shirts for sports wear have received the highest possible sanction.

The Prince of Wales wore one on the golf links at Le Touquet, with the sleeves cut off at the elbows. A rush upon the shops followed immediately, with such a demand for pink shirts that the shopkeepers had to telephone to Paris for more shirts. The pink cuffs were ruthlessly cut off and within a few hours the sartorially-correct young men at Le Touquet were sporting pink shirts with the sleeves "bobbed" at the elbows.

Word of the Prince's costume was apparently flashed to London at once. Almost at the same moment, a bold American was discovered on Piccadilly Circus adorned with a pink shirt, but whether he was consciously following Wales' lead is in doubt. The rest of his costume was sufficiently picturesque to attract the attention of Londoners.

He wore white sport shoes strapped with brown leather, black stockings and white knickerbockers, a blue serge coat under which the daring pink shirt gleamed beautifully, a red necktie and a felt hat turned up all the way around the brim, in elegant defiance of the down-turned brim made popular and almost universal by Wales.

SIXTH SENSE OF PLANTS IS FOUND

Most Minute Light Changes Are Detected.

LONDON, Aug. 17.—Plants not only have their vices, vanities and regular hours of sleep but some possess a sixth sense as well, according to Sir Pagadis Rose, one of Britain's greatest scientists and authorities on plant life.

The sixth sense possessed by certain species is a mysterious force which permits them to detect minute changes in the intensity of light, changes that go unnoticed by the human eye.

The mimosa plant spends its life in the leisurely way. It wakes gradually between 8 and 9 o'clock and naps, remaining alert until evening and falling fully asleep only in the early hours of the morning.

Sir Jagadis has perfected a marvelous piece of apparatus which gives plants under observation a questioning shock every-hour of the day and night and records the answers.




