

INCOMING SHIPS TELL OF STORM

One Which Relayed Messages Arrives in N. Y.

NEW YORK, Sept. 22.—Incoming ships brought stories to New York today of having been caught in the fringe of the West Indian hurricane which swept the southeast Florida coast, and told of the efforts which resulted in the first word of the Miami disaster reaching the outside world.

It was the Ward liner Siboney which relayed from Alfred P. Beck, United Press correspondent at Miami, the first dispatch telling of the hurricane.

"We were abreast Miami," Raymond D. Hutchens, the radio operator, said, "when I picked up exceedingly faint signals which said:

"Can you take care of messages to New York?"

Hutchens replied that he could and the messages from Beck were sent. It required two and a half hours to handle.

The Siboney had no difficulty, but did encounter rough weather.

The United fruit liner La Playa reported she was ahead of the storm and passed through Jupiter Inlet just before the storm broke.

The liners Lara and Maracaibo reported rough weather, but no serious trouble.

STATE OFFICIALS TO STUDY BORER

Joins Government Party in Canada Trip.

Headed by State Entomologist Francis N. Wallace, a group of State officials left today for Toledo from where an expedition will be led by Government officials into the corn borer infested district of Canada.

What is learned from the Canada trip will be used in combating the borer in the five counties in northeastern Indiana.

Accompanying Wallace will be Harry F. Dietz, assistant State entomologist; Paul Ulman, State corn borer expert; William Stahl, representing the Indiana Farm Bureau; State Representative Thurman A. Gottschalk, Berne, member of the legislative finance committee, and others. Thursday the group will confer in Toledo, with United States and Canadian experts. Friday the expedition will penetrate into Indiana and Essex Counties, Ontario, where the borer will be observed at work.

On Saturday the entire delegation will assemble in Detroit, to discuss means of preventing further spread in the Middle West.
