

BOARD FIGHT OR \$1.09 LEVY

Meeting Will Be Held
Delegations Make
Requests.

Meeting of the school board plans for defending the levy against the remonstrance by the Indiana Taxpayers' association at the State tax hearing Wednesday will be held this week, it was announced at a regular board meeting Tuesday.

The board will submit arguments to show that any cut in budget appropriations will reduce efficient operation of the city.

Urged to Attend
Delegations appearing before the board for new equipment and buildings were urged to attend the tax levy hearing and present their needs there. One group asked for a new branch library at Thirty-fourth and Clifton Sts., while a second asked for new equipment in school 46.

A letter from the South Side Boosters' Association supporting the levy was read at the meeting.

Appointments Announced
Several appointments, including members of night school staffs, which open Oct. 5, were announced by superintendent E. U. Graff. These schools will be held in elementary and the three high school buildings. About 2,400 pupils attended the schools last year.

Discussion arose over the salary of Carl Major, who succeeded Michael Madden, resigned, as assistant treasurer of schools. Two majority members of the board asked for a higher salary for Major immediately. This was reduced with advancement to be made Jan. 1.

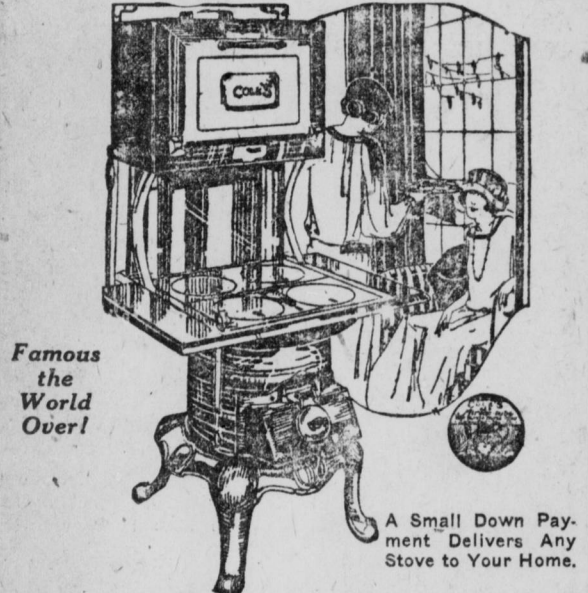
