

REPUBLICANS CUT WAR DEBT, TAXES, OFFICIAL ASSERTS

Schortemeier at Meeting.
Says Foreign Nations Must Pay.

Under the present Republican administration the World War debt and taxes have been reduced, asserted Frederick E. Schortemeier, secretary of State, in a Fourth ward meeting Monday night at No. 14 fire station, Kenwood and Thirtieth Sts. Schortemeier declared that all foreign indebtedness must be paid back to the United States.

"Whenever a party doesn't do the work of the people then it isn't worthy of support," Schortemeier said. He urged all voters to vote for whomever they thought best for their country, State and Nation.

Cites Principles
Schortemeier cited the principles of the Republican and Democratic parties and asserted that "I think a good deal more of a Democrat than

of a person who doesn't join any party."
"We should be proud of Watson and Robinson," said Emsley W. Johnson, chairman.
Little Opposition
Johnson said the Republican party has not much opposition in this campaign. He declared that all citizens should be proud of the showing made in State politics and glad of the work done in the country.
"The Republican party is the first to drive from its ranks those people who are not wanted," said Johnson.

COMMISSIONERS WILL BE ACTIVE

To Attend National Convention Nov. 9 to 12.

Members of the Indiana public service commission are to have an active part in the thirty-eighth annual convention of the National Association of railroad and public utilities commissioners, at Asheville, N. C., Nov. 9 to 12.

Two members of the commission are chairmen of important committees of the national body, Clyde H. Jones being head of the committee on motor vehicle legislation, and Frank T. Singleton being chairman of the committee on grade crossings and trespassing on railroads.

Jones will submit a report on motor vehicle regulation and has been honored with the chairmanship of the meeting on Nov. 11, the date when his report is to be considered. Singleton will submit a report on the findings of his committee.

Indiana commissioners will go to the convention armed with convincing arguments that the 1927 convention of the national body should be held in Indiana. The Indiana commission recently endorsed an investigation to hold the 1927 affair at French Lick.
