

100 SLAIN IN ANTI-FASCIST PLOT REPRISALS

MAYOR AND MAN MACHINE-GUNNED BY ILLINOIS GANG

Bloody Williamson County Scene of New Killings.

HERRIN, Ill., Nov. 8.—The feud spirit has gripped Williamson County—scene of many bitter factional battles—again, and today the toll from machine gun fire is two dead and one injured.

Mayor Jeff Stone of Colp, small mining village near here, and his friend, John Kilroy, a boxer, both were raked with a withering machine gun fire as they stood on the main street of the village Saturday night. John Keith, police chief, was wounded in the right arm.

Three Guns
The machine gunners wove through the city, three guns belching forth a deadly fire, in three motor cars.

It was declared in Colp that the shooting was the result of Stone having supported the Democrats in the elections last week. Stone, who is declared to have controlled most of the votes in Colp, is alleged to have been asked by a prominent gangster to support the entire Republican ticket.

Residents said more than a hundred machine gun and rifle bullets were fired by the attackers. Stone and Keith had been called to a roadhouse on the west side of the town. They were getting out of their auto-

After the shooting, the murderers' cars disappeared in the direction of Carterville.

Although there were several witnesses to the affray, they were reluctant to discuss it today.

"We didn't see anything at all," one bystander said. "If we were to admit that we did, we'd never see anything again."

9,000 Hear Aimee Brand Devil Liar

LOS ANGELES, Nov. 8.—The devil—"the greatest liar in Los Angeles"—personally devised the plot against her, Aimee Semple McPherson, evangelist, told a congregation of 9,000 in her Angelus Temple Sunday.

All the stories about her supposed trip to the seashore with Kenneth G. Ormiston, missing radio operator at the temple, and the "little blue trunk" with its red hair claws and women's finery, were creations of Satan, Mrs. McPherson said.

The evangelist, who is awaiting trial on charges of perjury and conspiracy in connection with her alleged trip, which she explained by telling a story of having been kidnapped and held for ransom, had promised a week ago to name "the greatest liar in Los Angeles" in her sermon today.

A vast audience gathered to hear her name him. Through a two-hour sermon, they heard the evangelist defend herself—but still the villain was unnamed. At the end of the sermon, Mrs. McPherson reached her climax and shouted:

"The devil—rival of Munchausen."

1,000 Injured, Hundreds of Ships and Homes Destroyed.

LONDON, Nov. 8.—Approximately one hundred persons have been killed and one thousand injured in Fascist reprisals for the attempt on the life of Premier Mussolini of Italy, according to dispatches from Lugano, Switzerland, to the Daily Herald. The reports say hundreds of houses and ships, owned by anti-Fascists, have been destroyed, and that whole families have been driven from their homes under pain of death.

The Daily Herald dispatch said that 150 persons have been driven from Lucca and also many from Padua, who had taken refuge in Milan. Among the victims of the reprisals destroyed, the dispatches said, were the noted Italian philosopher, Benedetto Croce, the playwright, Roberto Braccio, the Socialist leader and writer, Arturo Babroia and the communist leader, Bordiga.

It was reported that one of the richest libraries in Italy, that owned by Croce, also was destroyed. Homes of other prominent persons reported to have been destroyed were those of the Democratic leaders, Duca Di Cesaro and General Benicenga, and the Socialist leader, Claudio Treves.

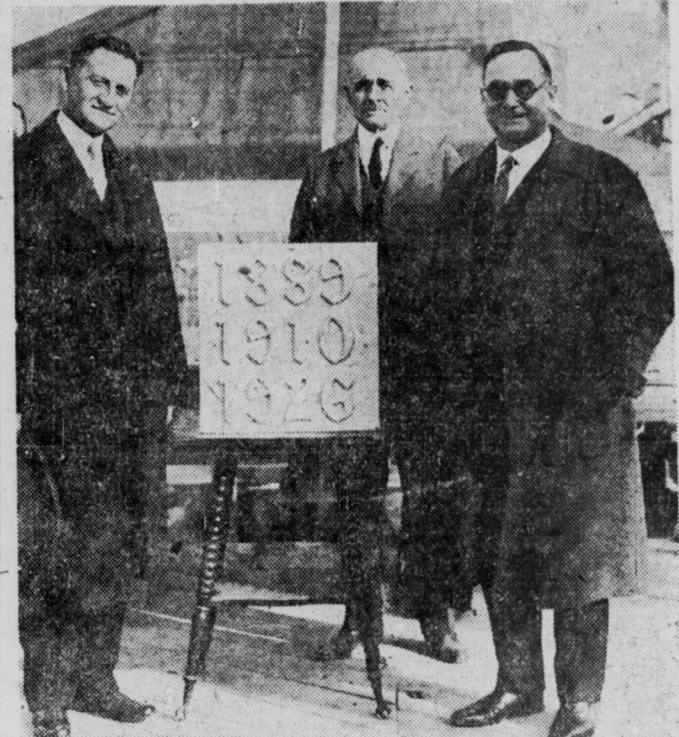
