Miss Bumbaugh, Daughter of City Aeronautics Pioneer, Selected.

Miss Kathleen Bumbaugh, alto singer, and Mrs. Helen Harrison, pianist, have been selected by civic committees to entertain at the Lindbergh party at Columbia Club, Aug. 9. Miss Bumbaugh is the daughter of Capt. A. L. Bumbaugh, pioneer in aeronautics in Indianapolis. Mrs. Harrison also will play harp sections during the evening.

Mayor John L. Duval will preside. Talks will be made by Col. Charles A. Lindbergh, G. M. Williams, president of the Marmon Motor Company and vice chairman of the Central Airways Co., United States Capt. H. W. Cook, Indiana National Guard.

The session will last two hours, beginning at 6:30 p. m. Accommodations will be limited to the first 500 persons who turn acceptances of invitations with \$5 fees. No demonstration will be arranged for Lindbergh when he alights at 2 p. m. at the Mars Hill Airport. He will be welcomed officially by members of the general executive and reception committees. Fences will be erected to keep the crowd back.

AIR EXCURSIONS ON WEEK-ENDS NEWEST SPORT

Service for City Will Be Given by Central Airways, Inc.

Central Airways, Inc., today announced special Hoosier aerial excursions each Saturday and Sunday at the Mars Hill airport.

Norman A. Perry, airways president, announced modern inclosed cabin airplanes will be available beginning this week to carry citizens of Indianapolis and surrounding towns for a view of the city.

Free buses will be operated from Monument Circle at noon Saturday and 9 a. m. Sunday to the Mars Hill field.
