

NAVAL OIL IS SEALED UP IN BIG RESERVES

Fields Restored After Long Court Fight and Production Halted.

WASHINGTON, Sept. 2.—The naval oil reserves which are leased out by Albert B. Fall now have been practically sealed up and the millions of barrels of Navy fuel are being held in the ground against the day of need.

Control of these tremendous oil fields was restored to the Navy Department, effective Aug. 1, by executive orders of President Coolidge cancelling the famous Harding order putting the Navy oil in the hands of Fall, then Secretary of Interior.

The great California naval reserves have been restored outright to the Navy Department, Doheny's Elk Hills lease having been canceled by the United States Supreme Court.

Doheny made three small California leases with Fall about the same time as the big Elk Hills lease. Suit for recovery was brought by the Government on the ground of fraud.

Closed Twenty-One Wells

The Navy has closed all of the twenty-one producing wells on the California reserves which once had an output of 1,500,000 barrels a year.

The Teapot Dome reserve in Wyoming, leased to Sinclair, is now held by receivers pending the outcome of the Government's suit to cancel the lease. The Government lost in the trial court, but won a reversal in the Appellate Court. Final decision will be made by the United States Supreme Court.

Russia's Klondike Connected With World By Quick Delivery
