Notice is hereby given to the taxpayers of the Sanitary District of Indianapolis, Marion County, Indiana, that the Board of Sanitary Commissioners of said District, at its regular meeting at 10 o'clock a. m., on the 11th day of February, 1928, in Room 313 City Hall, Indianapolis, Indiana, will consider and determine upon the matters contained in said Board's Resolution No. 144, duly adopted by said Board at its regular meeting on Feb. 2, 1928.

It is the order of said Board that the expenditure in 1928 of (a) \$16,000 for the purchase and installation of a steam turbine to replace a steam turbine which exploded on Sept. 20, 1927, in the power plant, and (b) \$15,000 to repair the damage (other than damage to turbine) caused by said explosion, and (c) \$30,000 to pay certain bills of the Board contracted in 1927 and now unpaid; all of which expenditures will be made from the cash balance of \$20,139.20 carried over by the Board from 1927 into 1928 and from \$7,631.31 out of the Board's 1928 appropriation, said Resolution No. 144, and a list of said unpaid bills, can be inspected at the Board's office.
