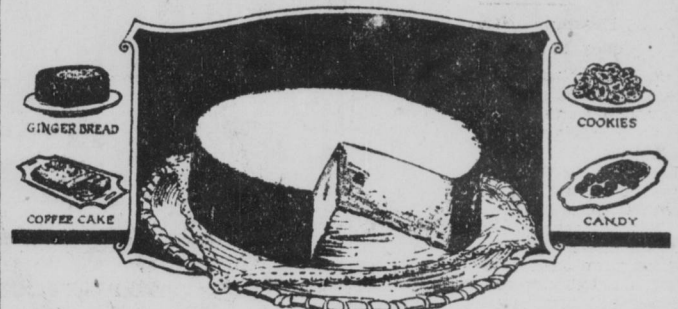
**THE RULES**

**Recipe for Southern Baked Ham**  
1 slice ham 1 to 2 inches thick  
1 teaspoon mustard, 1/2 cup brown sugar, 1 teaspoon Red Top Malt Extract (hop flavored)
