The call of an Arab lover, street noises of a Persian bazaar, the tinkle of camel bells, the cries of turbaned merchants in the early morning market place, soft melodies heard over the walls of a Chinese tea garden—all but the spicy odors of the ancient East—will come to listeners in the Siebeling Singers program at 7 tonight, over the NBC Red network from WEAF, New York. The new Siebeling Singers, under the leadership of James Melton, the famous tenor of the air, in keeping with their new program policy, will include a rare musical tribute—a rendition by the quartet of Cui's famous instrumental number, "Oriental." It has never been sung before. They will sing, besides, for the first time in quartet form, Ketelby's "Persian Market," also an instrumental piece, and "Japanese Sunset" by Deppen, a solo number.
