Read the chapter title of this piece of bunk burlesque that sometimes sounds like high art.

Here are a few titles for the pure—"One High Yellow an' Two Teasin' Browns," "Don't You Two-Time Me," "Outlaw Boys and Finish Fights," "Freezin' Ground Was My Foldin' Bed," "Oh, Lord, White Man, What Have I Done?" "Gamblin' for My Honey" and "Since I Laid My Burden Down."

Am telling you about a new book published by the Bobbs-Merrill Company under the name of "Rainbow Round My Shoulder," or "The Trail of Black Ulysses."

This book is the burlesque bunk of literature. Many a high brow is going to tell you about the O'Neill touch and all the other things that go to make up highbrow realism.

The "by" line on this piece of "literature" has the name of "Howard W. Odum." He has tried to make a "Black Trader Horn" out of this recital of a Negro who goes here, does that, takes this dame to that "experience," and works there and doesn't work here.

I am going to be told that this book is the heart and soul of the Negro. If that is true, then Booker T. Washington should take a lift out of his grave. And Roland Hayes should give up every ideal that he has.

A laugh may not be art and many miles from it. Here is black burlesque of literature. It may become a fad or worse than that. Any professor who does not know life may say this is a classic.

In this book is a bunch of things that will give the reader many a bum and cheap laugh. He tells you a thing under the introductory guise of a "doctor" of literature that is as much a joke as the black who is supposed to tell the story. Somebody has tried to make this book the "Black Trader Horn."

I do not believe that all the mud and that sex thing of many experiences is confined to any one man in either the black or white race. And, I, for one, am not going to give credit to any one incorporated male all the blame for that great activity.

If the so-called Black Ulysses actually lives and he tells the truth in this book, then every State that he mentions should get busy with judges, police, morals committee and every organization that kids itself upon law enforcement.

And there is one credit—as far as I remember, the State of Indiana was not mentioned in this wanderlust of this high-black, one-night Turkish harem parody.

TEACHERS WILL HELP ARRANGE STUDY COURSES

Wishart Asks Educators to Send Experts to Parley Here.

Uniform courses of study for every public school in the State, to be selected by the leading educators in each of the thirteen congressional districts after a series of conferences in the Statehouse, is the aim of Roy P. Wishart, State superintendent of public instruction.

"A course of study which will endeavor to give the student the utmost without digressions into by-ways or inefficient education is of utmost necessity," he declared.

"For years the courses of study used have been those offered by the publishers of the various textbooks adopted for use in the State. No expert attention to the problem of separating the wheat from the chaff has been given the courses.

Teachers to Aid Study

"It has been the custom to adopt the study course outlined by the textbook company and send these out to the teachers under the name of the State department of education.

"This has resulted in what might be termed to a certain extent as haphazard education not exactly fitted to the needs of the Hoosier student," he declared.

Wishart's plan calls for the selection by each county and city school superintendent of the teacher best qualified in the eight major subjects.

A process of elimination is then used by which the most qualified teacher in each subject is selected and the eight teachers from each congressional district will be called to Indianapolis.

Before coming here they will be furnished with memorandum sheets of the problems in education that must be met.

Discuss Work in Groups

Each teacher selected will be asked to have ready his or her own solution to the problem.

At the Indianapolis conference will be present acknowledged curriculum experts and they will discuss curriculum problems with teachers.

The teachers will be formed into groups in which their own subject will be discussed. A group chairman will be selected to guide the discussion, and acknowledged Indiana educators will be assigned to aid in the work.

Tentative courses of study in each subject will be adopted and then the teachers will take these back to their schools for observation.

At the end of a three-week period they will write what they believe to be the merits and demerits of each point in the course.

First Time Plan Is Tried

From this comment the courses will again be re-shaped and this draft will be sent the teacher to be placed under observation again.

Comments will be called for and the third draft will be that adopted. It will be the first time that the teachers themselves will be given an opportunity to express their ideas in regards to the method in which the subjects should be taught and will prove to be of undoubted value in determining the needs of the students and the remedy to be adopted, Wishart said.

ORDER GRAVES REMOVED

Mississippi Engineers Say Cemetery of 1812 in Levee Path.

By United Press NEW ORLEANS, March 15.—The graves of more than 200 war heroes in Chalmette National Cemetery, just south of New Orleans, must be disturbed after the occupants have slept peacefully since 1812.

Removal of the dead, all in the "unknown soldier" section is made necessary by the decision of Mississippi River engineers that an additional levee must be constructed through a part of the hallowed burial grounds to protect two southern Louisiana parishes from possible flood danger from high waters.



CONGRESS LOPS 30 MILLION OFF U. S. EXPENSES

Hacking Process Carries Budget Below Coolidge's Recommendations.

WASHINGTON, March 15.—Under admonitions from President Coolidge, Congress has hacked nearly \$30,000,000 from expenses of Government departments in appropriations for the coming year, a survey by the United Press disclosed today.

This unexpected slash leaves appropriations for ten of the eleven Government departments \$7,500,000 below what the Budget Bureau had recommended to Congress.

The decreases were made possible largely through curtailment of activities of the Veterans' and Pension Bureau and Land Office consolidations.

Increased appropriations were made in the following amounts, Treasury and Postoffice Departments, \$7,253,004; War Department, \$6,850,690; State, Justice, Commerce and Labor Departments, \$2,433,506; Agriculture Department, \$145,608.

But \$38,776,782 has been lopped off the Interior Department expenses and \$7,715,303 is being cut from the independent offices bill.

for 1929 just \$29,809,277 net below those of this year, with the Navy Department yet to be appropriated for.
