The speakers will be introduced to the radio audience by Charles G. Ross, chief of the Washington bureau of the St. Louis Post-Dispatch. Before presenting the speakers, Ross will give his regular fortnight review of "What Congress is Doing."

Charles Cheney Hyde, Hamilton Fish professor of International law at Columbia University, will deliver an address on "Fundamentals of International Law" which will be broadcast through stations associated with the NBC Blue network tonight at 6:30.

Professor Hyde, who was appointed by President Harding as the solicitor for the Department of State, February, 1923, prepared monographs on International law for the confidential use of the American Delegation at the Peace Conference in 1918-1919. Besides teaching in several universities, Professor Hyde is also the author of a number of works on international law.
