

NEW BRIDGES ARE OPENED UP FOR TRAFFIC

Offset Numerous Detours in
State Due to Starting
Building Work.

New bridges opened to traffic during the week numerically offset new detours caused by paving projects that were opened up according to the State highway department traffic bulletin today.

Director John D. Williams called attention to the work on Rd. 27 in the vicinity of Pokagon State Park in Steuben County, which is under way to completion and will be ready when the park rush starts.

Provision is now made for entrance to the park from the north, while the road is closed from a point one and one-half miles north of Angola to two and one-half miles south of the Michigan line.

On Rd. 9 the Mt. Etna bridge, under construction for several months, now is in use. Unusual activity prevails all over the system as the 400 mile paving program for 1928 is well under way, the bulletin states.

Detours, bridge run-arounds, for the week of April 28, May 4, are set forth in the bulletin as follows:

Rd. 3—Detour around grading three miles north of Madison.
Rd. 7—One-way traffic bridges eight and ten miles north of Madison.
Rd. 8—New gravel approaches to bridge at Mt. Etna are open to light traffic only; heavy traffic use marked run-around.
Rd. 10—Three and one-half mile detour at Culver.
Rd. 12 and 20—Partial detour in effect during daytime while completing bents to all on approaches to Baileytown over-head.
Rd. 18—Detour from four and one-half miles west of Lagrange to Steuben County line. Bridge run-around at State Detour in Elkhart. One-half mile detour at Rolling Prairie.
U. S. Rd. 24—Detour just east of Huntington.

No Jewelry

TERRE HAUTE, Ind., April 27.—Residents of nine Vigo County townships own no jewelry, according to statements made to tax assessors, who fully realize the residents were denying ownership of jewelry to escape paying taxes upon it. County Assessor Lee announces with a "lest you forget" warning between the lines, that he will make one more report to State authorities on the county's taxables and he expects it to contain true statements about jewelry in the nine townships.

U. S. Rd. 27—Detour north from Liberty. Bridge run-around three miles north of Richmond. Detour from Fountain City to Winchester. Detour two miles north of Berne to one mile south of Monroe. Detour one and one-half miles north of Angola to two and one-half miles south of Michigan line. Entrance to State park is open from the north.

Rd. 29—Detour just south of Greensburg. Fair local detour. Good three-mile detour two miles north of Burlington. Detour from two miles north of La Porte to Jct. of Rd. 20.

U. S. Rd. 30—Detour two and one-half miles west of Ohio line to seven and one-half miles southeast of New Haven. Portion of detour is narrow. Drive carefully between Warsaw and Plymouth. Short detour at Plymouth. One-fourth mile run-around at Erie R. R. crossing two miles north of Schererville.

U. S. Rd. 31—Run-around eleven miles north of Kokomo. Bridge run-around one mile north of Peru.

Rd. 32—Bridge run-around one and one-half miles east of Shannondale. Bridge run-around one and one-half miles west of Jct. of 29. Detour one and one-half miles west of Noblesville.

Rd. 34—Detour from Jamestown and Linton. Detour between Pittsboro and Brownstown. Through traffic between Indianapolis and Crawfordsville should use Rds. 52 and 32 via Lebanon.

Rd. 35—Narrow between Corydon and Palmyra. Short detour at Abner's Creek east of Danville.

U. S. Rd. 36—Short detour at Grantsburg. U. S. Rd. 41—Bridge run-around just south of Lyford. Detour between Attica and Boswell. Bridge run-around two and one-half miles north of Keokuk. Detour at John to north of Keokuk.

Rd. 45—Closed for construction between Greensburg and Chicago. Traffic to use Rds. 52 and 32 via Lebanon.

Rd. 46—Narrow approaches to bridge three and one-half miles east of Nashville.

Rd. 50—Bridge run-around four miles west of Washington. Bridge run-around just west of Seymour. Watch for workmen between Dillsboro and Aurora.

U. S. Rd. 52—Short detour in Ottoburn. Detour in Lebanon around paving

by city. Drive carefully northwest of Merriam where workmen are finishing bents. Closed for paving from four miles southeast of Rushville to Andersonville. Detour marked. Closed from Brookville to State line at West Harrison for paving. Detour for local traffic via New Ellettsville. Brookville to Cincinnati traffic detour via Scipio and Ohio Rds. 126 to Venice, then on U. S. 27 to Cincinnati over Corran Ave. Indianapolis to Cincinnati traffic use Rd. 52 to Rushville, then Rd. 44 to Connersville, then Rd. 1 to Brookville, then over detour described for Brookville to Cincinnati traffic.
Rd. 53—Detour three miles south of Rr. 10 to Rd. 10.
Rd. 56—Closed for construction between West Baden and Paoli, with only fair detour. Earth surface between Salem and Scottsburg is impassable most of time. With two miles of earth road across river bottoms between Rogers and Sandy Hook impassable in wet weather. (Traffic best route over good gravel road.) Detour south of Washington account bridge construction. Rd. 59—Bridge run-around three miles north of Jct. of Rd. 54.
Rd. 62—Detour between Corydon and New Albany for construction. No suitable local detour. Through traffic route via Palmyra via Rds. 35 and 150. Run-around four miles west of Evansville for one-way traffic only.
Rd. 63—Bridge run-around five miles north of Mt. Vernon.
Rd. 66—Detour between Evansville and Newburg. Impassable between Newburg and Hatfield with no detour. Through traffic route via Rds. 45 and 62 until further notice.
Rd. 67—Bridge run-around one-fourth mile south of Bruceville.
U. S. Rd. 150—Under construction from West Baden and French Lick to Paoli. Detour for local traffic between West Baden and Paoli. Detour between Paoli and Palmyra. Through traffic from Vincennes to New Albany route over Rd. 59 at Jct. of 150 to Rd. 37 near Mitchell, thence on Rd. 37 to Paoli, thence on Rd. 56 to Salem and thence on Rd. 35 and back to Rd. 150 at Paoli.
Roads not mentioned and parts of roads mentioned but not specified are in excellent condition.

SOMERSET, England, April 27.—

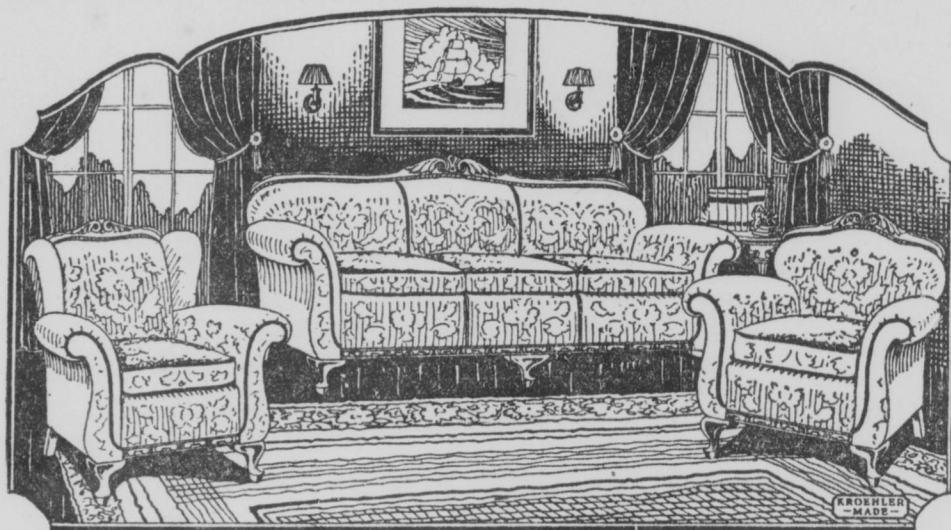
